The Gespe'gewaq Mi'gmaq Resource Council is seeking an Interim Manager for the Aquatic Research Unit, to provide leadership in aquatic and natural resource research and policy development for the communities the GMRC serves, namely, Listuguj, Eel River Bar, and Pabineau. The Interim Aquatic Research Manager reports to the Executive Director.

### **Sample of responsibilities**

Responsible for organizing and implementing projects and programs, delegating tasks associated with projects, performing statistical analysis and complete interim and final reporting requirements

Preparing and reviewing environmental documents and reports as the project progresses

Plan, schedule, organize, and lead field-work for scientific projects

Responsible for advising on issues brought forth from concerned community members by advising and developing solutions

Provide consultation and recommendations on protection/mitigation of Mi'gmaq natural resources

Responsible for sourcing outside funding programs. You will design and implement projects for needs as specified by all three communities keeping in the mandate and vision of GMRC.

## **Qualifications**

Bachelor's degree in one of the natural science disciplines – Biology, Wildlife Biology, Ecology, Wildlife Management, Environmental Studies, Resource Management. Preferred specialization in Fisheries and/or Aquatic Habitats.

Management/Business Degree/Certificate/Diploma is an asset.

The incumbent must have a minimum of 5 years experience working in management, preferably in a scientific capacity.

Candidate must have experience working with First Nation communities and be familiar with First Nation issues.

The incumbent must have proven experience working with multi-stakeholders groups, industry, and other resource users.

Should have knowledge of the area: Restigouche River, Nepisiquit River, Chaleur Bay, and surrounding areas.

Equivalent combinations of education and experience will be considered.

Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
